Introduction

The European Space Agency (herein the "Agency" or "ESA") is an intergovernmental organisation established by its Convention opened for signature in Paris on 30 May 1975. The Protection of Personal Data is of great importance for ESA, which strives to ensure a high level of protection as required by the ESA Framework on Personal Data Protection (herein the "ESA PDP Framework") which applies for processing of Personal Data at ESA, available at:

The ESA PDP Framework applicable for the processing of Personal Data within ESA is composed of the following elements:

- the Principles of Personal Data Protection, as adopted by ESA Council Resolution (ESA/C/CCLXVIII/Res.2 (Final)) adopted on 13 June 2017;
- the Rules of Procedure for the Data Protection Supervisory Authority, as adopted by ESA Council Resolution (ESA/C/CCLXVIII/Res.2 (Final)) adopted on 13 June 2017; and
- the Policy on Personal Data Protection adopted by Director General of ESA on 5 February 2018 and effective on 1 March 2022

Scope of this Privacy Statement

This notice is intended to inform you about the processing of your personal data and more specifically about:

- the identity of the Data Controller and contact details of the ESA Data Protection Officer ("DPO");
- the type of personal data collected and processed;
- · the modalities of collection of personal data;
- the purpose and legal basis of the collection and processing;
- the recipients to whom the personal data of the Data Subject is disclosed;
- the time-limits for storing the personal data;
- your rights and the modalities by which you can exercise them and the practical modalities of exercising
 your rights and those rights of other persons, when processed in this Processing Activity under the
 ESA PDP Framework.



Description and the Purpose for this Processing of your Personal Data: What is this processing about?

This notice is intended to describe why and how Your personal data are collected and processed by, or on behalf of, ESA, as Data Controller, upon initiative of ESA CIC-I Department, as well as what rights You have in relation to Your personal data. It must be read in conjunction with the ESA PDP Framework and other privacy notices referred to herein.

ESA as Controller processes your personal data to organise and manage the Industry Space Days, commissioning ATPI (the Netherlands) Services as Processor. For these purposes only as well as for the purposes mentioned in Article 5 of ESA Policy on Personal Data Protection, ESA is Data Controller. ESA does not instruct any third party to conduct any web analytics, profiling, or any other processing on ESA's behalf, other than the purposes mentioned.

Members of selection committees or bodies that select abstracts may act as separate Controllers and may be in territories not having an Adequate Level of Protection such that ESA implements appropriate protection for Disclosures of personal data.

Social media, LinkedIn, Twitter, external websites, etc., may be used to publish photographs, video recordings or interviews or information related to the events. These act as separate Controllers, each responsible for their personal data processing activities, please consult their privacy notices and websites for further information. You have the right to decline your participation in such processing.

Your Personal Data will be processed by ESA and its Processor ATPI to enable your participation in the event. This includes your banking and/or credit card information if you choose to pay via this method.

Through the Proximum365's ViMeet platform, you will be able to network with other participants. On the Platform you can provide relevant professional information, which is processed by ESA and its Subcontractors based on your consent.

At the event, photos and videos will be taken which will be later published on ESA websites and social media platforms, for example, LinkedIn and Twitter/X. You may opt-out of the publication of your photos and videos by wearing a special lanyard provided at the event, which indicates your preference not to be photographed. You may also inform the photographer directly about your wish not to be photographed or recorded.

ESA processes the personal data of participants for the following purposes: managing invitations, registrations, participation requests, facilitating remote participation and distribution of the list of participants, managing on premises presence, badges and identity verification for security, promoting the event in social media. ESA also processes personal data of participants for reporting on the event, to distribute presentations to participants and potentially for satisfaction surveys. Where you have consented, ESA may keep your contact details in order to invite you to future similar events or future meetings within the scope of the activity. Your personal data may be accessed by the ESA event organisation team and service providers (ESA Conference Bureau, ATPI Services) under ESA contract, ESA workforce members of the HIF-E team and ESA IT support teams.

We collect and process Your personal data because it is necessary for the activities conducted to fulfil Our purpose, which is "to provide for and to promote, for exclusively peaceful purposes, cooperation among European States in space research and technology and their space applications, with a view to their being used for scientific purposes and for operational space applications systems" (as per ESA Convention). We serve the public interest, and we seek to foster the public interest in space activities and programmes. All the processing carried out by, or on behalf of, ESA upon initiative of the HIF-E Department falls in this general purpose and, in particular, into one of the reasons permitted under ESA PDP Framework, in particular under ESA PDP Policy. ESA initiates webinars, conferences, symposia, events and workshops for the purpose of promoting the space industry and enhancing collaboration. Video recordings are created to enable those not present at the event or the interested public to view it for educational purposes via ESA social media or websites, etc. In any case, we do not use your personal data for activities where our interests are overridden by the impact on you, unless we have your consent or are otherwise required or legally permitted.



Legal Basis: What is the legal basis for processing the personal data?

On what legal grounds do We collect and process Your data?

We process Your personal data pursuant to the ESA PDP Framework, in particular pursuant to Article 5 of the ESA PDP Policy, for fair, specified and legitimate purposes or for purposes compatible therewith. The processing of your personal data by ESA for this event is lawful as it is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest.

Generally, the processing referred to in this notice falls under Article 5.2.1.i. of the ESA PDP Policy, i.e.:

- (a) for the performance of an activity carried out by the Agency within its purpose and in the framework of, and in conformity with, the ESA Convention, the Policy on Personal Data Protection adopted by Director General of ESA on 1 March 2022 "Agreement between the States Parties to the Convention for the establishment of a European Space Agency and the European Space Agency for the protection and the exchange of classified information" done in Paris on 19 August 2002, and the applicable rules and procedures, including ESA Security Regulations and Directives; this includes Processing necessary for the Agency's management and functioning, Dispute Resolution Procedure, and or Investigation Procedures; or
- (b) for the performance of a contract concluded by the Agency within its purpose in relation with an activity carried out by the Agency in the framework of, and in conformity with, the ESA Convention and the applicable rules and procedures;
- (c) for Your legitimate interest; or
- (d) for purposes covered by Your Consent, where applicable, as it may be obtained from You under a separate document (e.g., Consent form).

In addition, We may process Your data under Article 5.2.2 of the ESA PDP Policy concerning Sensitive Personal Data, i.e. when the processing:

iii. is necessary for:

- a) the protection of the vital interests of the Data Subject or of another natural person where the Data Subject is physically or legally incapable of giving Consent; or
- b) Dispute Resolution and Investigation Procedures; or
- c) Depending on the situation, we may consider that your consent is given by various modalities and may result from affirmative motions (e.g., swiping on a screen), browser settings, written statements, filling an electronic online form, sending an email, uploading a scanned document with their signature, using an electronic signature and other modalities that may appear in the future.

Your rights (Data Subject Rights) How can you access, erase, rectify, complete or amend your personal data?

You have the right to be informed in a transparent manner about: the processing of your personal data (the Controller, purpose, recipients, etc.); your rights and the modalities of exercising these, (e.g. erasure, rectification, completion, or amendment as per the conditions under PDP 5.1. i.; right for every interested Data Subject to lodge a complaint before the Supervisory Authority in case the former demonstrates or has serious reasons to believe that a Data Protection Incident occurred in relation with his/her Personal Data, following a decision of the Agency (e.g. Data Protection Officer). The right of information under PDP 5.4.1 i. and the right of access under Section 5.4.1 ii. shall not apply: (a) where and insofar as the Data Subject is already in possession of the information; (b) for the right of information, when processing of Personal Data is necessary for any Investigation or Dispute Resolution Procedure; (c) for the right of access, where and insofar such access would conflict with an Investigation Procedure concerning the Data Subject.

We seek to respond without undue delay, and in any event within one month of receipt of the request. However, that period may be extended by two further months where necessary, taking into account the complexity and number of the requests. You will be informed of any such extension, together with the reasons for the delay.

If you wish to submit a complaint to the ESA Data Protection Supervisory Authority, you are required to comply with the Rules of Procedure of the Supervisory Authority set forth in the ESA PDP Framework:

You will be required to demonstrate that a Data Protection Incident occurred in relation to your personal data, following a decision of the Agency or at least be able to provide serious reasons and indicators to establish that such an incident occurred.
